When the flyer, controller, or other special duty position does not meet a specific medical standard, they require an aeromedical waiver. The waiver guide is your cookbook for this process.

You can't enlist with a permanent medical disqualification unless you receive an approved waiver. If you are found to be permanently disqualified, the MEPS doctor will indicate on your medical form whether a waiver is recommended in your case. It is the first step in the medical waiver process.

For the Air Force, as defined in AFI 33-360, a waiver is a tool commander's can use “to enhance mission effectiveness at all levels, while preserving resources and safeguarding health and welfare.” Once approved by a commander, a waiver signifies that the approving commander has
